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Summary



■ Performance highlights



- ◆Achieved highest-ever sales and profits, growing for the eight consecutive year
 - While the tax leasing arrangement business led the continued expansion of consolidated sales growth, other businesses including the insurance brokerage business, the real estate business, etc. increased by 14.4% yoy and also contributed to the sales growth.
 - Operating income ratio increased to 63.7%, maintaining strong profitability.

Business Overview



■ Tax leasing arrangement business



- Achieved record Sales and equity placement, continuing to expand
 - Through the strong demand of investors for Japanese Operating Leases, yoy sales increased by 11.2%, to 18.96 billion yen, and yoy equity placement increased by 5.8%, to 115.74 billion yen.
 - Originating and selling high profit products led to a high commission fee margin of 17.1%

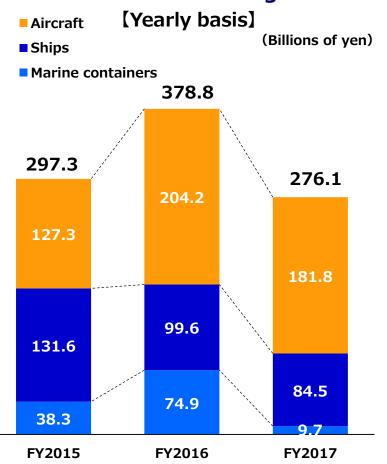

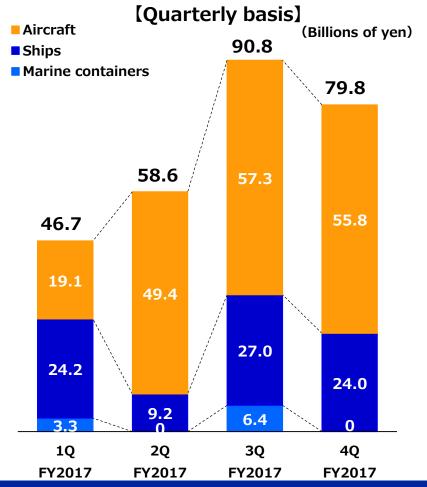

Developments in Origination Volume



- As for aircraft, the total amount of assets arranged continued to be at a similar level as the previous year by developing new lessees and large-scale deals.
- As for marine containers, the total amount of assets arranged decreased temporarily because of extraordinary factors such as the management teams of container lessors being focused on post-merger integration issues, etc.





■ Japanese Operating Leases



- There are two types of Japanese Operating Leases:
 - (i) JOL (Japanese Operating Leases without Call Option)
 - (ii) JOLCO (Japanese Operating Leases with Call Option)

■Topics(1) –Strengthening the origination and sale of JOLs for aircraft

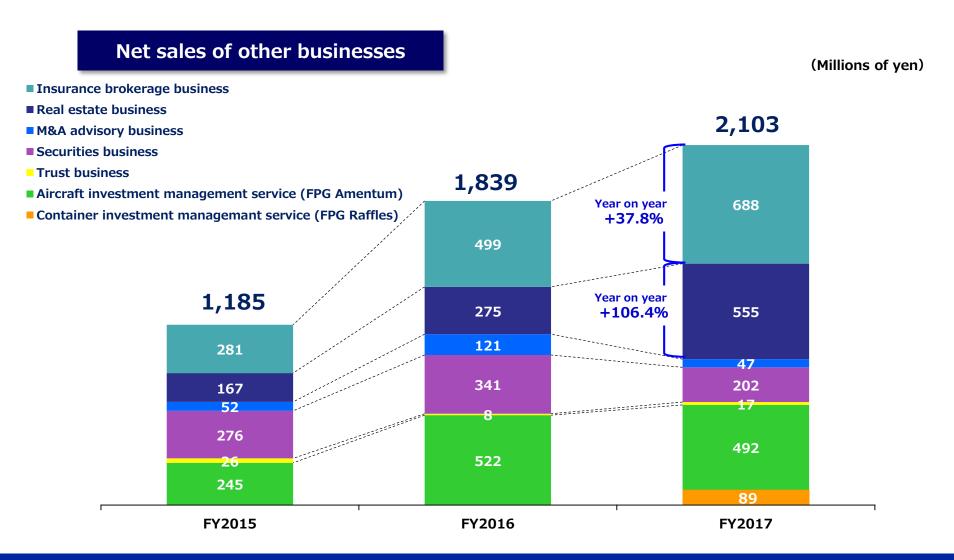


- ◆ Strengthening the origination and sale of JOLs in partnership with FPG Amentum
 - Most of our projects are JOLCOs. Since we formed a capital and strategic alliance with FPG Amentum, we have been actively structuring pure operating leases (JOLs) for aircraft by making use of FPG Amentum's remarketing capabilities.
 - Achievements of JOLs business in FY2017
 - 1. Began providing JOLs for aircraft using a trust structure
 - ➤ Taking advantage of our unique competitive advantage of having a trust company and an aircraft management service company in the FPG group to do the first Japanese operating lease for aircraft using a trust structure
 - 2. Implemented the origination of large volume JOLs
 - > Accepted an order for 11 aircraft at lower prices

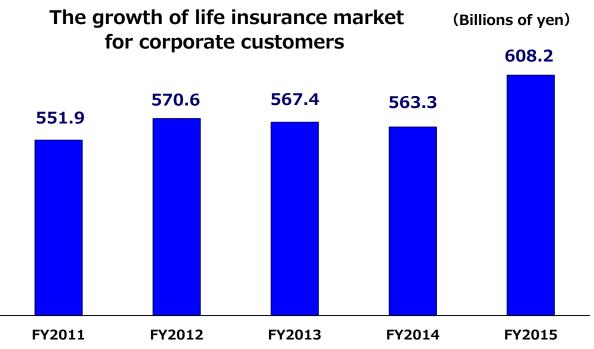
♦ Insurance brokerage business and Real estate business have developed and driven expansion in net sales of other businesses.



■ Topics(2) –Achieving steady growth of insurance brokerage businesses



- **♦**Life insurance for corporate customers is a profitable market. Hence, we achieved the increase of sales through investing in the human resources.
 - The life insurance market for corporate customers is over ¥600bn, and our company is expected to have room to expand in this market.
 - Sales in this business have expanded greatly because of allocating insurance experts to all our branches and tapping into SMEs demands.

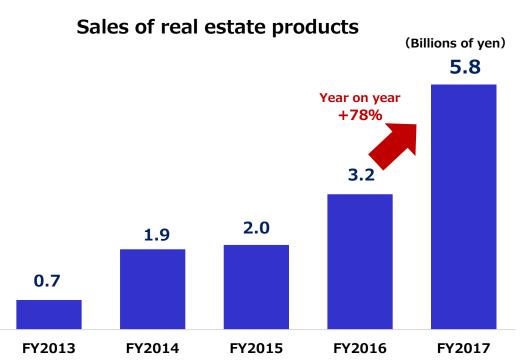

■ Topics(3) – Expansion of Real estate business



- **◆**Expanded the origination capacity because of successful purchases of property located in the best districts of central Tokyo
- ◆Increased sales significantly due to expansion of our product lineups
 - Working on developing the third distribution network channel in addition to the distribution network of alliances with accounting firms and financial institutions
 - > Launched WEB marketing over the Internet, such as listing ads





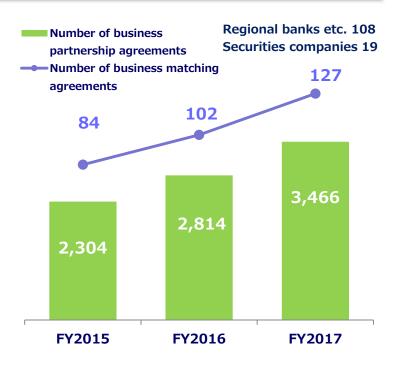
■ Distribution network



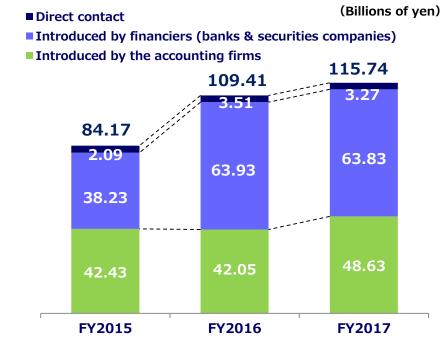
◆Created more alliances with accounting firms and financial institutions

- Sales network expanded steadily. Number of partner accounting firms increased by 652, reaching 3,466 in total, while the number of partner financial institutions increased by 25, reaching 127 in total.
- Equity sales through accounting firms increased by 15.6% yoy, reaching 48.63 billion yen.





Transition of equity sales (through accounting firms and financiers)

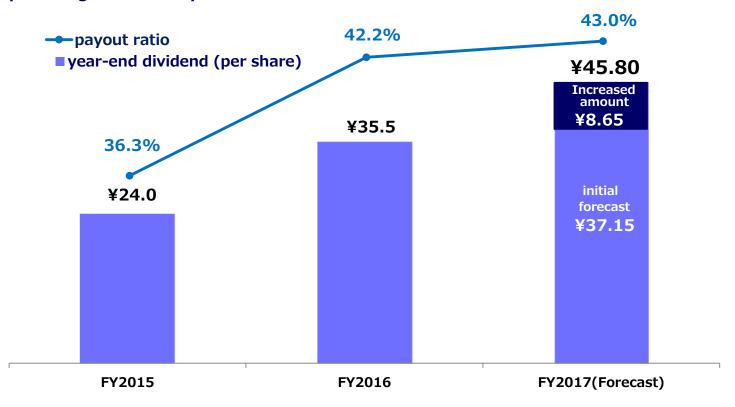


■ FY2017 Dividend forecast



◆ Increased year-end dividend forecast from ¥37.15 per share to ¥45.80 per share

- Our basic profit distribution policy It attaches great importance to returns to shareholders and the stable, continued payment of dividends, after guaranteeing internal reserves for future business development and improvements in business quality.
- The year-end dividend forecast was revised upward to ¥45.80 per share from ¥37.15 per share due to the favorable consolidated financial results. The resulting consolidated payout ratio will be therefore 43.0%.
- We have decided that the target consolidated payout ratio is revised to over 40%, from over 30%, from FY2018, to provide greater clarity to our shareholders.

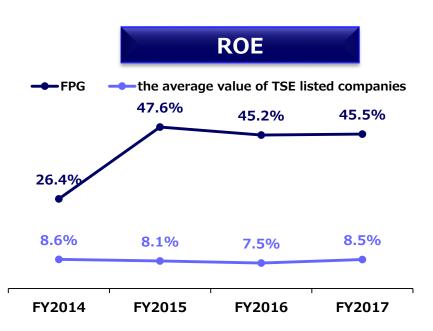
