3. Reason for Relocation

Our company moved into the current Harajuku office in 2018 and has been operating there for approximately six years. During this period, the number of employees increased significantly from 19 to 130 in Japan, and although we expanded within the floor, the number of staff has well exceeded the office's capacity.

Despite adopting a hybrid work model of remote work and office attendance after the COVID-19 pandemic, we face challenges such as securing meeting rooms and spaces for online meetings

With the relocation, the number of available seats will increase significantly from 93 to 197. Moving forward, we will encourage employees to work in the office more actively and conduct company-wide meetings within the new office space, aiming to enhance communication among employees and boost engagement through various initiatives.

Considering the expected continued increase in the number of employees, the need to improve productivity through the provision of adequate seating and meeting rooms, and the goal of strengthening business continuity, we have decided to relocate.
