2. Overview of CASBEE Real Estate Certification

CASBEE is a system for evaluating the comprehensive environmental performance of buildings that has been developed and disseminated in Japan under the initiative of the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism. CASBEE Real Estate Certification is a system in which a third-party organization reviews the assessment content of buildings that have been assessed by CASBEE - Real Estate and certifies that the assessment is accurate. The assessment is displayed on a four-level scale (S rank: excellent to B rank: required items are met). CASBEE - Real Estate has been used to evaluate four property categories: offices, stores, logistics facilities, and housing complexes.
