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1. Overview of operating results and others

(1) Overview of operating results for the six months ended September 30, 2025

In the six months ended September 30, 2025, the business environment surrounding the Group was characterized by robust corporate earnings, which underpinned steady capital investment demand, including for automation and digital transformation (DX) as measures to address the labor shortage problem.

On the other hand, there is continuing concern that the impact of U.S. tariff policy will cause an overseas economic slowdown, and a high level of uncertainty remains about the future, particularly concerning the downward pressure on the domestic economy and the impact of rising prices.

Under these circumstances, the Group is striving to enhance its technological and planning capabilities as part of its efforts in the final year of its five-year medium-term management plan, Electronics Solutions-Company 2025 (ES-C2025), with the aim of becoming an "Electronics Solutions Company" that contributes to solving social issues and achieving sustainable growth through its SDG initiatives.

In spite of these efforts, the factory automation field continued to be affected by inventory adjustments, resulting in sluggish performance. However, the Information & Communications Equipment business performed robustly and the Infrastructure business saw an increase in large-scale projects.

As a result, net sales in the six months ended September 30, 2025 increased \$9,845 million year on year to \$61,657 million, and ordinary profit increased \$277 million year on year to \$1,807 million. Profit attributable to owners of parent increased \$306 million year on year to \$1,198 million.

(i) Factory Automation Systems business

In the factory automation field, sales of controller systems and drive control equipment remained sluggish due to the prolonged inventory adjustment impact, but power distribution control devices trended toward recovery, leading to flat performance year on year.

The industrial mechatronics field saw a decrease in projects for electric discharge machines and laser processing machines.

Performance in the industrial systems field was robust in instrumentation systems for the manufacturing sector, but overall it stayed flat year on year due to the absence of last year's large-scale projects.

As a result, although net sales increased by ¥2,552 million for the segment, ordinary profit decreased by ¥222 million due to the sluggish performance in the high-margin factory automation field.

(ii) Building Facilities business

In the facilities equipment field, demand for power supply systems for information and communication operators continued and remained robust.

In the air conditioning and refrigerating equipment field, demand for air conditioning equipment trended toward recovery while performance for refrigeration equipment stayed flat year on year.

As a result, although net sales increased by ¥679 million for the segment, ordinary profit decreased by ¥73 million due to lower profit margins resulting from the impact of large-scale projects in the facilities equipment field.

(iii) Infrastructure business

In the transportation field, wireless communication and substation equipment remained strong, helped by the recovery trend of capital investment of railway operators.

The social systems field performed well, supported by steady performance for the defense-related business and a steady stream of large-scale government projects.

As a result, net sales increased by ¥5,378 million and ordinary profit increased by ¥201 million for the segment.

(iv) Information & Communications Equipment business

In the telecommunications field, sales of image and video equipment were flat year on year, and electronic medical devices performed well as the number of projects increased.

In the semiconductors and devices field, sales of industrial power devices struggled owing to the decreased demand, while sales of electronic devices used in office automation equipment were robust.

As a result, net sales increased by \(\xi\)1,233 million and ordinary profit increased by \(\xi\)207 million for the segment.

(2) Overview of financial position for the six months ended September 30, 2025

(i) Assets, liabilities and net assets

Total assets at the end of the six months ended September 30, 2025 were \\$80,290 million (a decrease of \\$8,790 million from the end of the previous fiscal year).

Current assets were ¥62,596 million (a decrease of ¥9,414 million from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to decreases of ¥10,151 million in accounts receivable – trade, ¥385 million in accounts receivable – other, and ¥285 million in merchandise and finished goods, which outweighed increases of ¥930 million in advance payments to suppliers, ¥527 million in cash and deposits, and ¥204 million in electronically recorded monetary claims – operating, each compared to the end of the previous fiscal year.

On the other hand, current liabilities were \(\pm\)30,792 million (a decrease of \(\pm\)9,641 million from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to decreases of \(\pm\)8,605 million in accounts payable - trade, \(\pm\)1,613 million in electronically recorded obligations - operating, \(\pm\)528 million in accounts payable - other, \(\pm\)288 million in accrued consumption taxes, and \(\pm\)255 million in

provision for bonuses, which outweighed an increase of ¥2,233 million in advances received, each compared to the end of the previous fiscal year.

Non-current liabilities were ¥978 million (an increase of ¥320 million from the end of the previous fiscal year).

Net assets were \(\frac{\pmathb{4}}{48,519}\) million (an increase of \(\frac{\pmathb{5}}{529}\) million from the end of the previous fiscal year). This was mainly due to increases of \(\frac{\pmathb{3}}{324}\) million in retained earnings mainly due to the recording of \(\frac{\pmathb{1}}{1,198}\) million in profit attributable to owners of parent and \(\frac{\pmathb{8}}{868}\) million of dividends paid, and \(\frac{\pmathb{4}}{45}\) million in valuation difference on available-for-sale securities, which outweighed a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathb{2}}{255}\) million in foreign currency translation adjustment, each compared to the end of the previous fiscal year.

As a result, the equity ratio at the end of the six months ended September 30, 2025 was 60.4%, and net assets per share were \(\frac{4}{2},176.17\).

(ii) Cash flows

At the end of the six months ended September 30, 2025, cash and cash equivalents were \(\pm\)17,150 million, an increase of \(\pm\)726 million (up 4.4%) from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The status and factors affecting the increase or decrease of each cash flow during the six months ended September 30, 2025 are as follows:

Cash flows from operating activities

Net cash provided by operating activities for the six months ended September 30, 2025 was \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1,984}\) million (compared to \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1,223}\) million provided in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly due to the securing of \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1,825}\) million in profit before income taxes (\(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{1,646}\) million in the same period of the previous fiscal year), a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{10,066}\) million in accounts receivable - trade and contract assets, and an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2,234}\) million in advances received, which offset a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{10,421}\) million in trade payables, an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{9}}{930}\) million in advance payments to suppliers, and \(\frac{\pmathbf{5}}{59}\) million in income taxes paid.

Cash flows from investing activities

Net cash used in investing activities for the six months ended September 30, 2025 was ¥229 million (compared to ¥108 million used in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly due to ¥199 million in proceeds from withdrawal of time deposits, which was offset by ¥308 million in purchase of property, plant and equipment, ¥74 million in purchase of intangible assets, and ¥82 million in payments for investments in capital of subsidiaries and associates.

Cash flows from financing activities

Net cash used in financing activities for the six months ended September 30, 2025 was \\$882 million (compared to \\$1,400 million used in the same period of the previous fiscal year), mainly due to \\$864 million in dividends paid.

(3) Explanation of consolidated earnings forecast and other forward-looking statements

At present, our consolidated earnings forecasts for the full year remain unchanged from those announced on May 16, 2025.
