1. Overview of Operating Results, etc.

Since TOBISHIMA HOLDINGS Inc. (the "Company") was established on October 1, 2024 through a sole share transfer, as a wholly-owning parent company of Tobishima Corporation, no information is provided for the six months ended September 30, 2024.

(1) Overview of Operating Results for the Six Months Ended September 30, 2025

During the six months ended September 30, 2025, the Japanese economy was on a moderate recovery trend, backed by the solid state of employment and private consumption environments, despite continued high prices and declining real wages. However, conditions have been uncertain about the future, mainly due to U.S. policy trends such as trade policy, the slowdown in China's economic growth, and geopolitical risks.

The domestic construction market requires continued careful observation due to the persistently high prices of labor, materials and equipment, although public investment has remained firm, and private capital investment has also shown signs of recovery, partly backed by strong corporate earnings.

Under these circumstances, for the six months ended September 30, 2025, net sales were \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{64.1}\) billion, operating profit was \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{3.0}\) billion, ordinary profit was \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2.6}\) billion, and profit attributable to owners of parent was \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{3.0}\) billion.

The Group's net sales tend to be concentrated in the second half of the fiscal year, especially in the fourth quarter, and thus there are seasonal fluctuations in its business performance.

Business results of each reportable segment are as follows.

(Construction Business (Civil Engineering Business))

In the Civil Engineering Business, net sales of completed construction contracts were ¥29.6 billion, and segment income was ¥2.0 billion.

(Construction Business (Building Construction Business))

In the Building Construction Business, net sales of completed construction contracts were \(\frac{4}{23.9}\) billion, and segment income was \(\frac{4}{1.4}\) billion.

(Growth Business, etc.)

In the Growth Business, etc., net sales were ¥10.6 billion, and segment income was ¥1.5 billion.

Note: For the above figures by reportable segment, net sales represent "Sales to third parties," while adjustments have been made between segment income and operating profit in the semi-annual consolidated statements of income.

(2) Overview of Financial Position for the Six Months Ended September 30, 2025

As for the financial position as of September 30, 2025, assets decreased by \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{2.7}\) billion from the end of the previous fiscal year to \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{1.54.4}\) billion, due to an increase of \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{3.3}\) billion in costs on development business and other in progress, primarily attributable to a rise in real estate development in progress by a consolidated subsidiary and a decrease of \(\frac{\pmathbf{\frac{4}}}{9.1}\) billion in cash and deposits, chiefly as a result of a decrease in deposits received, primarily attributable to the allocation of joint venture construction costs to other companies.

Liabilities decreased by ¥3.4 billion from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥103.2 billion, mainly due to an increase of ¥0.6 billion in advances received on construction contracts in progress, an increase of ¥1.1 billion in borrowings, a decrease of ¥2.3 billion in notes payable, accounts payable for construction contracts and other, and a decrease of ¥2.1 billion in deposits received, primarily attributable to the allocation of joint venture construction costs to other companies.

Net assets increased by ¥0.6 billion from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥51.1 billion, mainly due to the posting of profit attributable to owners of parent of ¥1.9 billion, and the payment of cash dividends for the

fiscal year ended March 31, 2025 of ¥1.7 billion.

Equity ratio was 33.1%, up 1.1 percentage points from the end of the previous fiscal year.

Going forward, the Company will accelerate the promotion of strategies designed to expand the future revenue base by investing in new and existing businesses while at the same time increasing equity.

Cash and cash equivalents ("cash") as of September 30, 2025 decreased by ¥9.1 billion from the end of the previous fiscal year to ¥16.3 billion.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash used by operating activities in the six months ended September 30, 2025 was \(\frac{\pmathbf{7}}{2}.7\) billion due to cash decreasing factors, such as an increase in costs on development business and other in progress of \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3}.3\) billion, primarily attributable to a rise in real estate development in progress by a consolidated subsidiary, an increase in consumption taxes refund receivable of \(\frac{\pmathbf{1}}{2}.2\) billion, a decrease in trade payables of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}.3\) billion, and a decrease in deposits received of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}.1\) billion, primarily attributable to the allocation of joint venture construction costs to other companies, despite cash increasing factors, including the posting of profit before income taxes of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}.6\) billion and a decrease in real estate for sale by consolidated subsidiaries of \(\frac{\pmathbf{2}}{2}.6\) billion.

(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used by investing activities in the six months ended September 30, 2025 was ¥0.6 billion mainly due to purchase of property, plant and equipment of ¥0.4 billion.

(Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash used by financing activities in the six months ended September 30, 2025 was ¥0.6 billion mainly due to net decrease in short-term borrowings of ¥0.7 billion, primarily attributable to repayments of funds borrowed for seasonal working capital, proceeds from long-term borrowings of ¥4.6 billion, repayments of long-term borrowings of ¥2.8 billion, and dividends paid of ¥1.7 billion.

(3) Explanation of Consolidated Financial Results Forecast and Other Forward-looking Information There is no change to the consolidated financial results forecasts for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 as the Company believes that they are within the range of the forecasts announced on May 14, 2025.

[Qualitative Information on Non-consolidated Orders Received and Non-consolidated Orders Forecast]

As for the non-consolidated orders received for the six months ended September 30, 2025, the Civil Engineering Business was ¥38.6 billion, down 1.3% year on year, and the Building Construction Business was ¥18.2 billion, up 21.6% year on year.

The full-year non-consolidated orders forecast remains unchanged from the beginning of the fiscal year, after careful consideration of the actual results for the six months ended September 30, 2025 and the future project situation.
