■ Reasons for the new version

Universities in Japan are in a phase of major changes in their activities. Competition for students among universities is increasing as the country's age-18 population declines. In addition, universities are expected to play a role in revitalizing regions of Japan as well as in lifelong education programs such as recurrent education and reskilling. The resulting diversity of university students, including graduates and other adults, has significantly altered the environment for university operations. Universities are responding by upgrading academic capabilities and operating more efficiently to meet the demand for a broader range of assistance for students while maintaining financial soundness.

The GAKUEN Series assists universities with the use of ICT to further upgrade the academic environment and operate more efficiently. In addition, this series makes extensive use of generative AI and other leading edge technologies. These features are based on JAST's commitment to enabling academic activities at universities to benefit from the latest advances in technologies. GAKUEN RX2.0, the newest member of the GAKUEN Series, incorporates generative AI as well as an entirely updated system platform. Furthermore, the UI/UX was improved and services and functions were strengthened to reflect the requests of users.

■ Features of GAKUEN RX2.0

(1) Functions that use generative AI

This is the first member of the GAKUEN Series that has functions made possible by generative AI. Capabilities include course selection tips for students, answers to questions, assistance for preparing a syllabus, and other support. By providing assistance backed by AI, GAKUEN RX2.0 lowers the amount of work performed by instructors. These functions are expected to result in even higher satisfaction among GAKUEN Series users.

(2) Easier smartphone use of digital student ID cards and other items

Usability is much higher due to major redesigns of the smartphone site/app. In addition, many more functions are accessible from the smartphone app. Including a new digital student ID card function in the smartphone app benefits students by simplifying class attendance records, ID confirmations and other procedures.

(3) Robust security due to the use of multi-factor authentication

Even better security due to multi-factor authentication reduces the risk of unauthorized access. The update of the system platform provides compatibility with the latest OS and middleware components. These improvements create a secure system environment that people can use with confidence.

(4) Academic administration function upgrades

Functions involving university administrative tasks are enhanced to handle complex procedures and complete tasks faster. Features include compatibility with the limit of 60 units for students taking classes remotely, disclosure of a web API, and Learning Tools Interoperability (LTI) support for seamless links with external tools. Users will also appreciate the new version's work flow function (a product for completing internet applications and other forms), which has been expanded to include instructors, that makes entering information in surveys, applications and other forms faster and easier.


■ Plan for the release of GAKUEN RX2.0

The first step was the November 2025 release of the initial version of GAKUEN RX2.0. Beginning in the spring of 2026, JAST plans to add more functions to this product.
